Positive Support is a information, advice and support service for people living with or affected by Hepatitis C and/or HIV . Our service is available to anyone living in Lanarkshire and our goal is to help people to live positively with Hepatitis C and/or HIV and to ensure individuals and communities have better access to advice, support and treatment.

We recognise the importance of ensuring service users are at the forefront of service delivery. Those affected by BBV's are best placed to decide on the type of support, information and services they need and we endeavour to ensure their voices are heard.

Positive Support is an Addaction project and we empower clients to take charge of their lives and place them at the heart of our organisation. Positive Support began in April 2011 and is funded by NHS Lanarkshire.

What can Positive Support offer?

- One to one support with dedicated support worker
- Help and advice about treatment
- Help and support toward and during treatment
- Accompany to hospital appointments
- Tailored Assessment and Personal Care Plan
- Personal goal setting
- Signposting and referral to other agencies
- Lifestyle change and information
- Transmission and risk reduction advice
- Peer Support groups

We provide outreach support and are happy to meet service users in their local area or outwith, if desired.
